

Hope and Recovery Project (HaRP)

Service User Trainers

Are you interested in delivering recovery training for staff working in SLaM?

We are looking to recruit service users to do joint training for our recovery training project.

About our project

We are running a two year trustee funded project named the Hope and Recovery training Project (HaRP). Our training has been designed in consultation with service users, carers and staff.

HaRP will be running workshops on recovery for staff working in the trust across adult services. There will also be access to eLearning which includes service users, carers and staff DVD talking about recovery journeys.

The project is coordinated by the Recovery Lecturer Practitioner and there will also be 5 CAG Practitioner Trainers to help support teams in recovery orientated practice development. The training will be run jointly with the recovery trainers and service users which takes place over three day workshops.

What we are looking for:

We are looking to recruit service users who are on the service user involvement register or are self employed and are:

- Experienced in delivering training to mental health staff on recovery orientated practice
- Able to deal with challenges in the training environment with the support for a co-trainer.
- Knowledgeable and have an understanding of recovery
- Skilled in supporting staff to develop and implementing recovery orientated practice
- Committed to enabling staff learning

What we can offer:

We are offering an opportunity to deliver training over a period of 18 months, beginning from Jan 2012. The training comprises of three days and depending on experience you would be required to co-train on either the first or the last day of the training.

The training will mainly be delivered at Bishopsgate Training Centre, Bethlem Royal Hospital with some at Lambeth Hospital training centre. Agreement on attendance to co-deliver the training will be arranged in advance.

We will be recruiting a maximum of 10 service users. Each will be given an opportunity to deliver up to 8 full days each over a 18 month period. Payments will be through the involvement register or invoices for self employed trainers. This will be discussed further at interview.

HaRP will also be running a 5 day training for trainer's course. Successful applicant will be required to commit to attending all days. This will run on 5th, 6th, 9th, 10th and 11th Jan 2012.

Responsibilities and Role:

- To deliver training jointly with the recovery lecturer practitioner and/or one of the 5 practitioner trainers.
- To be able to manage challenges in classroom learning with the support from the practitioner trainers.
- To be a part of the continuous training review and regular team meetings
- To attend the five day training for trainers
- To ensure commitment to staff learning
