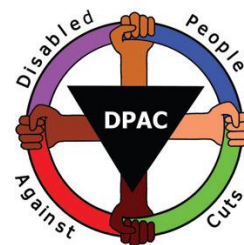

- **1900 people** in Bromley are affected by bedroom tax. 14% for an extra bedroom means that people in Bromley have to find an extra **£12 a week**.
- The **benefits cap** comes to Bromley on **15th April**, which is **£350 for a single person** and **£500 for a couple**, or single parents with children living with them.
