Bedroom tax and Benefits Cuts

- ▼ 14% for an **extra bedroom** means that people in Croydon and Bromley have to find an extra £12 a week.
- ▼ The benefits cap is £350 for a single person and £500 for a couple or single parents with children living with them.
- **▼ Speakers** from the Labour Representation Committee, Disabled People Against Cuts, Defend Council Housing and the Right to Work campaign.

NO EVICTIONS CUT RENTS NOT BENEFITS

April 1st was no joke as the government's benefit cuts became reality and our lives got harder, as if they weren't hard enough already!

The Coalition cut peoples' housing, council tax, unemployment, disability benefits and more. They want to force us out of social housing for having a 'spare' bedroom, or accept cuts to our benefit if we don't.

80,000 people face being moved out of London.

Two thirds of the 660,000 people affected by the bedroom tax nationally are **disabled people**.

The benefits cap is being **trialled** in Bromley and Croydon, with most affected families in Croydon previously receiving under £32,240 a year in benefits.

The cap takes no account of need and unfairly targets **single parents**. 70 per cent of those affected nationally will be **children**.
